

BACK YARD FIRES:

There is NOT a fire ban on in the Village, but if the dry weather continues that may change. The Village's Open Outdoor Fire Bylaw prohibits lighting any fire in the Village except for a fire started in a fire pit, fire ring, fire box, or a similar device designed for cooking or recreational use.

Burning of any garbage, garden refuse, or anything that may generate an offensive odor is prohibited.

- Pick up after your pet. Dog & Cat waste is a health and environmental hazard
- Don't let you dogs/cats roam onto other peoples property

Dog License Fees: All dogs in the Village are required to have a license.

-\$35 for a new dog licence.

-\$35 for renewal Jan 1 - Feb 28. After Feb 28 renewal fee is \$40.00.

CATS: The Village does not have a Cat Bylaw. They don't require a license.

Development/Building Permits:

Does your next construction project require a permit?

Many common improvements to your property may require a permit:

- New builds (Fence, shed, garage or dwelling)

-Demolitions, repairs or alterations to an existing structure -Moving structures on or off your property

All applicable permits are to be in place before any work has been started. For more information on permits and fees contact the Village Office.
